Monthly Report - Dec 2024







EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

We trust that everyone had a good Christmas holiday, and we wish the whole KDC Team all the very best for 2025!

Good progress has been made during the month of December 2024, with the completion of Whakpirau Rehab as well as the commencement of Slip Repairs left over from Cyclone Gabriel. We are currently preparing Surveys, Designs and Estimates for the repair of these slips.

Pre-Seal repairs for this year's re-seal sites have also progressed well and we envisage having these completed by the end of January 2025. Re-Seals are programmed to start from late Feb/March 2025.

We are now entering the dry season and plan to slow down work on the unsealed network until the wet season starts in late March 2025. During December 2024 we managed to maintenance grade 111km and repair 216 potholes. During the month we managed to reduce the Unsealed Road RFS's down to zero.

Drainage works - We have also managed to clear 31 culvert ends and reinstate 2115m of water tabling across the network.

We have started planning and programming Rehabilitation works on Moir Street in Mangawhai which is to start in Feb 2025. We are busy with Investigation and Design works for Victoria Street which was brought forward from the FY25/26 program to this year.

Seal Extensions – Cames road and Settlement Road works have started. Estimates for the Blackswamp, Devich Road and Lawrence Road are underway.

To the upper right is the monthly roading report numbers for the different activities completed during December 2024.

CUSTOMER REQUESTS

Please refer to bar chart below (RHS), which indicate a downward trend in RFS numbers since the start of the ne Contract. (Start in July 2024 averaging around over 200 RFS/month down to 110 in Dec 2024)

During the month of December 2024, we received 110 number request for services from our Customers. (reported up to the 23rd of Dec 2024) There has been a drop in the Unsealed Road related RFS, only 30 received during the month which may be a good indication that the condition of the Unsealed Road in improving. The majority of our request for services continue to be related to the Sealed Road Network.

During the month we have managed to reduce the outstanding RFS's related to the Unsealed Network down to zero.

"Dear all, A big thank you to all involved in getting the road repaired at Lincoln St for the summer.




Freyburg St – "just wanted to say thanks so much for the team doing the water blasting outside the four square and down towards the end of the shops. It looks terrific!"

SEALED MAINTENANCE & SEALED RENEWAL ACTIVITIES

Pre-seals for the re-seal sites deferred from the previous year (Contract) is progressing very well (approximately 79% complete). December has seen works progressing on both Preseal repairs and targeted maintenance sites. Preseal repairs are programmed to continue in January with reseals programmed for late Feb 25/March 2025.

Whakapiaru Rd rehab is now completed with the first coat seal being applied on Wednesday 11th December. Moir St rehab is planned to start late February 2025 Victoria Street rehab is in the investigation/design phase.

Key challenges include:

- Agreeing on carrying out more maintenance works around preseal sites. (allocating budgets for this)
- Waterproofing of the network appears to be a real issue due to the back log from the previous Contract (deferred sites)
- There are significant other general maintenance repairs needed across the network, which are being prioritized.

Key work undertaken on the sealed network includes:

- Approximately 79% of the pre-seals needed to re-seal the sites deferred from last year has been completed.
- Programming a preventative sealing maintenance program focusing on high priority sites that need urgent intervention.
- Programming of works for upcoming Rehabs Moir Street.

UNSEALED MAINTENANCE ACTIVITES

During the month we managed to get the outstanding RFS's for the Unsealed Road down to zero. We are entering drier months and will be minimizing works across the 1126km unsealed network. We anticipate to start increasing works again from late March 2025. We are managing the remaining budget by identifying sites that need to be programmed with allocated quantities.

Key challenges include:

- Policy change in the utilization of Local Sub-Contractor rates. Some progress has been impacted.
- Limited budget to maintain a 1126km unsealed road to an acceptable standard.
- We are moving into a drier season.
- Aggregate loss is challenging as there is nothing to actually grade and improve the shape.
- Poor drainage and high shoulders is creating scouring, dropouts and potholes.

Key work undertaken on the unsealed network in July includes:

- 111 km of Unsealed roads Graded during the month
- 216 potholes repaired
- 1274 m3 of metal strengthening completed.

DRAINAGE MAINTENANCE ACTIVITES

We continued to focus on clearing inlet and outlet stormwater culvert ends. 31 culvert ends completed this December 2024. We also inspected all the critical flood area culverts before the Christmas holiday and nothing significant to report.

2115 meters of water tabling has also been completed this month.

Programmed works include the pre-seal sites requiring drainage as well as programming the culvert clearing ahead of the Unsealed Maintenance Program.

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

A key component of this contract is to support the local economy and local businesses by using local suppliers and subcontractors. A Local Spend Target of 30% has been set.

During the Tender and Procurement Stage the Local Suppliers had their opportunity to submit their prices to KDC of which nine Local Suppliers were pre-approved through KDC procurement process. This included a set of rates approved by KDC.

Recently this work model has been challenged, which may hamper the progress on achieving the 30% Target. Discussions in progress to find a way forward.
