

Public excluded items 11 June 2020

The following recommendation is made in reliance on section 48(1)(a) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 and the particular interest or interests protected by section 7 of the Act.

On the grounds that matters will be prejudiced by the presence of members of the public during discussions on the following items, it is recommended:

a) That the following items are considered with the public excluded:

Confirmation of public excluded minutes 12 March 2020	Protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons (Section 7(2)(a)) Protect the information which is subject to an obligation of confidence or which any person has been or could be compelled to provide under the authority of any enactment, where the making available of the information would be likely to damage the public interest (Section 7(2)(c)(ii)) Avoid prejudice to measures protecting the health or safety of members of the public (Section 7(2)(d)) Enable any local authority holding the information to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, commercial activities (Section 7(2)(h)) Enable any local authority holding the information to carry on, without prejudice or disadvantage, negotiations (including commercial and industrial negotiations) (Section 7(2)(i)) Prevent the disclosure or use of official information for improper gain or improper advantage (Section 7(2)(j))
Contract monitoring and reporting	Enable any local authority holding the information to carry on, without prejudice or disadvantage, negotiations (including commercial and industrial negotiations) (Section 7(2)(i))
Potential claims update	Enable any local authority holding the information to carry on, without prejudice or disadvantage, negotiations (including commercial and industrial negotiations) (Section 7(2)(i))
Investigation update	Protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons (Section 7(2)(a)) Avoid prejudice to measures protecting the health or safety of members of the public (Section 7(2)(d)) Enable any local authority holding the information to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, commercial activities (Section 7(2)(h))
Cyber security incident	Protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons (Section 7(2)(a)) Avoid prejudice to measures protecting the health or safety of members of the public (Section 7(2)(d)) Enable any local authority holding the information to carry out, without prejudice or disadvantage, commercial activities (Section 7(2)(h))
