

# Strategic Asset Management Plan - Transportation

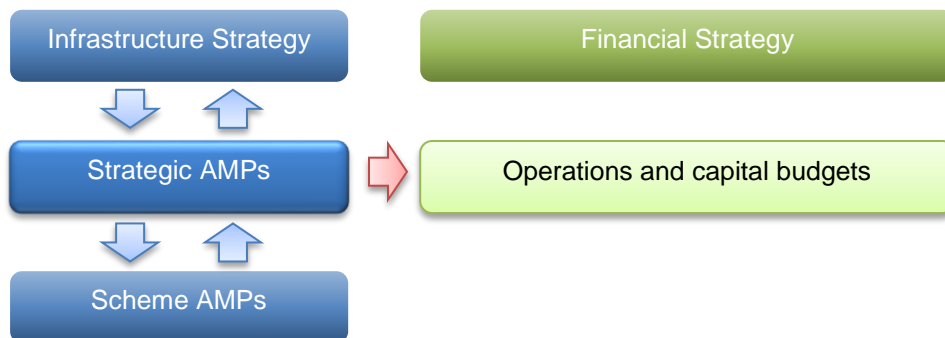

## Purpose/Ngā whāinga

To update Council on the progress of the Strategic Asset Management Plan (SAMP) for transportation, and seek feedback which will be incorporated into the Long Term Plan (LTP).

## Context/Horopaki

SAMPs form a key part of the LTP and sit under the Infrastructure Strategy.



The Draft Infrastructure Strategy has a 30-year horizon and illustrates how we will respond to key issues, trends and growth.

There are seven SAMPs (with a 10-year horizon) for

- Water
- Wastewater
- Stormwater
- Land drainage
- Waste minimisation
- Parks and open space
- Transportation.

## Discussion/Ngā kōrerorero

The focus of today's discussion is the **Transportation SAMP**. The other draft SAMPs were presented to Council at the July 2020 Long Term Plan Briefing.

A presentation on the new Transportation SAMP will be circulated to elected members before the briefing for their consideration.

Feedback from Council will be used to inform the refinement of the Strategic Activity Management Plans.
