

# Climate Adaptation Joint Committee - Iwi appointments

## Purpose/Ngā whāinga

To provide the Council with the recommended Iwi representatives to be appointed to the Joint Committee on Climate Adaptation (the “Committee”).

## Recommendation/Ngā tūtohunga

That the Kaipara District Council confirms and appoints the following as the Kaipara District Council Iwi representatives on the Joint Committee on Climate Change Adaptation:

- a) Fiona Kemp of Te Uri o Hau as the primary representative.
- b) Taoho (Snow) Tane of Te Roroa as the alternate.

## Discussion/Ngā kōrerorero

On 30 September 2020, Council agreed to establish the Committee with the Northland Regional Council, Whangarei District Council, and the Far North District Council.

As part of this agreement and decision, Council staff were tasked with approaching Te Roroa and Te Uri o Hau as our Iwi partners, to work with them on the appointment of a primary and alternate representative (on the Committee).

This process is now complete, and the representatives can now be confirmed by Council.

Iwi have recommended the following appointments be made by the Council to the Committee:

- a) Fiona Kemp of Te Uri o Hau is recommended to be the primary representative
- b) Taoho (Snow) Tane of Te Roroa is recommended to be the alternate.
